GOLFWEEK NAMES BLACK BEAR TOP GOLF COURSE IN LA

For the sixth consecutive year, *Golfweek* magazine has named Black Bear Golf Club in Delhi the No. 1 public access course in Louisiana. Two other members of Louisiana's Audubon Golf Trail claimed top-five spots on the list released in the March 12 issue: TPC Louisiana in Avondale and Carter Plantation in Springfield.

"Black Bear Golf Course and Lodge are wonderful facilities owned by the people of Louisiana," Lt. Governor Jay Dardenne said. "It does not surprise me that *Golfweek* recognized this gem in north Louisiana and two other great courses on the Audubon Golf Trail. Black Bear Golf Course has topped *Golfweek's* list since 2010. The top-five Louisiana courses also include Contraband Bayou in Lake Charles and LaTour in Mathews. Black Bear Golf Club is managed by the Office of State Parks.
