VERSAILLES, October 1st., 1741

Laws and ordinances regulating the nominations of tutors in the colonies.

When minors, after their father and mother's death are left in possession of real estate or other properties in France and in the Colonies, a tutor must be appointed in France and another one in the Colonies.

Those in the Colonies will be under the jurisdiction of the local judges.

Minors wishing to get married will have to obtain their tutor's consent, with the approval of a family council certified by a judge. Judges in the Colonies will supervise the revenues of the minors, residing in that Colony.

The tutors will supervise the education of the minors.

Minors will not be allowed to sell any negro working on their plantations until they are twenty-five years old.
