PETITION FOR RECOVERY OF SLAVE.

François Chastang, having Power-of-Attorney to act for De Louboey, Knight of St. Louis, Lieutenant of the King in this Province, and Commandant for the Department of Mobile, deposes and says that:

According to agreement under private signature, between De Louboey on the one part and Sr. Melisan and his wife Magdeleine Boyer on the other part; (1) De Louboey was to surrender to Melisan and his wife, one negresse by name, Junon, said negresse being pregnant at the time.

(2) Melisan and his wife, Magdeleine Boyer, in turn would surrender their negresse, Manon and give 50 piastres additional for the prospective child.

Both negresses to be in sound health, but a few days after exchange was consummated the negresse Manon became ill and according to the testimony of various persons, it was proven that she has been an epileptic for some time.

Petitioner prays for the return of his negress, he in turn to give back to Defendant his sick negress Manon, plus the fifty piastres for the prospective child.
