Title: Intestado. Autos hechos por fin y muerte de la Negra nombrada Marton.

Location: Louisiana State Museum, Historical Center, Spanish Judicial Records, RG 2, 17 January 1774

General Information: On the morning of 13 January 1774 the negra libre Martha died intestate and with no heirs except one son named Pedro, a slave who belonged to the Reverend Father Bernabé, Capuchin priest of the German Coast. She had some goods and furniture and a house in New Orleans. These were sold at public auction, the proceeds going to her creditors and, what remained, to her son.

Sale of the household goods brought 64 pesos and 2 reales; sale of the house brought 100 pesos, for a total of 164 pesos, 2 reales. The estate's expenses were as follows:
